Previously, He has been involved in a running battle with George Osborne, the chancellor of the country as well as 100 Tory Member of Parliament over the issue of bringing cuts in subsidies for winding farms along with the of the efforts of the chancellor in order to encourage the development of more number gas-fired power stations.

The renaissance that came in the field of nuclear power has been badly threatened by the withdrawal of things such as EON as well as RWE, which are two of the major utilities of the Germany that have come as a result of new planned developments in this field. The Government is making attempts to encourage the nuclear investments by the way of making long-term price agreements without direct subsidies which will be becoming the cause of confusion as well as will be drawing scathing criticism from the Member of Parliament in their report.
