If you have suffered from a workplace injury or an occupational illness, a workersâ€™™ compensation lawyer can provide you with information about the workersâ€™™ compensation system. As your workersâ€™™ compensation lawyer would explain, the workersâ€™™ compensation system pays injured workersâ€™™ medical bills if the injuries are ongoing and prevent a worker from returning to his or her job. Additionally, a workersâ€™™ compensation lawyer can help you receive reimbursement for any out of pocket medical expenses resulting from a workplace injury or illness. The lawyer will also inform you about certain time constraints when filing a claim within the workersâ€™™ compensation system.

If a worker died as a result of a workplace injury or occupational illness, the spouse, and minor children of that worker may be eligible to death benefits. These benefits include the coverage of funeral expenses up to six thousand dollars, and weekly payments of a portion of the workerâ€™™s wages. Again, it is best to speak with a workersâ€™™ compensation lawyer, about what benefits you are eligible to as a family member of a deceased worker.

A workersâ€™™ compensation lawyer will also help you to determine if you are qualified for any other benefits to supplement your workersâ€™™ compensation benefits. For example, a worker may also be entitled to social security disability, unemployment insurance, and union benefits. For this reason, it is best to consult a full service law firm or workersâ€™™ compensation lawyer regarding your case, as he or she will be well-versed in the law and will be best able to assist you in receiving all of the benefits that you are entitled to as a worker or family member of a deceased employee.
