Eventually, Acer has got the Windows 8 fever for a good cause. Soon after the announcement of the Windows 8 Release Preview on May 31st, Acer has ventured into the Windows 8-based products, viz. Aspire S7 Ultrabook, ICONIA W Series tablets, and Aspire U Series all-in-one (AIO) desktops. Ergonomics and style are the two prime areas where Acer has focused to provide simplicity to users, and combination of responsive Windows 8 touch, Intel's 3rd generation Intel Core processor, innovative Acer Twin Air cooling system and light-sensing keyboard are to further add values to computing.

The ICONIA W510 (10.1― display-size) and W700 (11.6― display-size) tablets are spearheaded with the Always Connect technology, and support for up to 18 hours of battery life. Aspire U Series AIO desktop descends in two sizes- 7600U, 27-inch and 5600U 23-inch that can swivel at 360 degree-and don the best-of-class ergonomics to complement interior decor. Thus, Acer has revamped the tablet and desktop computing experience. However, the official launch date of the discussed Acer models will depend upon the induction of the Windows 8 RTM (Release to Manufacturer) which is expected to be somewhere in the first week of July. So tech support and tech media portals which are eager to assess the performance of new products will have to wait till August or late to come up with Acer reviews. Consumers are recommended to go through those before investing their hard-earned money.

Pampering the current buyers the brand has come up with Windows 8 Upgrade offer as well that goes in compliance with the Microsoft Eligibility Criteria that reads "any Windows 7 PC purchased from June 2, 2012 to January 31, 2013 will be eligible for the upgrade―. Clearing the fog on Wednesday i.e. June 20 it has announced the upgrade option for new Timeline Ultra M5 ultrabooks that starts at \$679.99. All buyers certifying the eligibility norms will be required to register their products at the Microsoft's site that will ask some personal information such as name, contact details, email address, PC purchase details, etc. Microsoft laid down an upgrade price of \$14.99, and the program is available in 131 countries in 37 languages.

Have questions as where to go for Windows 8 Upgrade Acer Aspire Support service?
