There are 13.1 million people in the United States who use assistive technology devices according to the National Institute on Disability and Rehabilitation Research. Many of the devices help people who have difficulty walking or maintaining stability and include walking sticks or canes, walkers, wheelchairs and back braces. The 13.1 million people includes 3.8 million who wear hearing aids. These numbers don't include those who have limited vision.

People with disabilities have problems managing major activities that include keeping house, walking around the home or facility, and maneuvering around furniture and other small and large items. It is important that as many barriers as possible be eliminated to make daily activities easier and safer to complete. In many situations, one step that can be taken includes replacing the flooring that presents safety issues with vinyl flooring.

Everyone wants to live with dignity. It doesn't matter what type of physical problem exists because living with dignity and safety is a human rights issue. One way to promote both life qualities is by installing flooring that minimizes hazards and promotes maneuverability.

However, each of these flooring styles can present challenges for some people with disabilities. For example, it's difficult to roll a wheelchair on carpet. Wood flooring is wheelchair maneuverable but can create a glare, distort the sound of footsteps and be too slippery for people who have difficulty walking.

Keep Choices Low Key

When choosing vinyl flooring for people with disabilities, it's wise to avoid choosing designs with broad stripes or wavy patterns. You should also avoid geometric designs. Muted colors and quiet designs are better choices for people with disabilities in many cases because they are not distracting.

For ultimate safety and maneuverability, vinyl sheeting is a good choice. The number of seams are minimized so there's less change of edges coming loose from the glue and curling. However, vinyl tiles are also very safe. In either case, routine maintenance should include checking for loose tiles.
