Likewise every package that they offer will have a fair sprinkling of everything in their stable, but you can expect each package to have a central theme like for example a package that emphasizes cable TV, one on internet and still another on digital home phone. The various permutations and combinations will give you so much of choices that will make your head go spinning. Here below is a guide on choosing the right internet speed based on the kind of activity for which you want an internet service.

- i.1 Mbps Occasional web surfing, email, instant messaging, news and weather reports.
- ii.1.5 Mbps â€" Fast web surfing, email with heavy attachments, online shopping, banking transactions, medium size files and low quality streaming video.
- iii.3 Mbps â€" Video rich surfing, sending and receiving images, downloading music files, education and high quality streaming videos.

iv.15 Mbps and above â€" Multi user surfing, sending and receiving very large files, high quality digital videos and movie downloads.
