Before the end of your day, stop at one of the numerous eateries and enjoy local tapas. Tapas are little dishes or snacks that are readily available in almost all bars and restaurants. This is an ideal way to sample many of the local foods. Don't forget to combine your tapas with one of the local drinks. A good place to go is La Carboneria. This old coal warehouse offers live music and an excellent selection of drinks.
