If none of the above indicators apply, and you simply feel it is time to replace them, you can jack up your car and remove the wheels, and then you will be able to clearly see if the brake pads are worn down. Now the last indicator you will want to avoid, since this is when you hear metal screeching when you hit the brakes. This means you might have waited too long and will undoubtedly need to change the brake pads as soon as possible, if not do more.

The undeniable fact that BMW body parts tend to be expensive must be more than enough of a reason to ensure that you replace the brake pads on time, since if it is too late the brake discs is likely to be damaged. The reason the brake discs will get damaged is simply because if the pads are worn away completely, then it gets to be a metal on metal process which will scrape away at the brake discs and damage them. Also remember that you should replace the brake pads in pairs, either you replace both the front pads or the two rear pads simultaneously.

After your BMW brake pads had been changed it is advised for you to run the car in a stationary position and press against the brake pedal a couple of times. If it sounds fine, then you will be ready to drive your vehicle around safely. Also, on average it will take about 100 to 200 miles to brake in the pads, therefore it is recommended that you must not be too rough on the brakes for that period. In case you do not comply with this, it will damage your brake pads and discs again.
