The typical mixture for spray foam consists of two ingredients: polyurethane and isocyanate. As the polyurethane mixture is sprayed onto the area to be insulated, the isocyanate mixes into the polyurethane when the spray foam is applied. The isocyanate is an essential ingredient if spray foam is to settle as real foam.

The result is a sea of spray foam across the roof that looks like white cotton candy laid out to dry. Due to the hazards of the chemicals involved in the spray foam, application should only be done by certified roofing contractors. Exposure to isocyanate can trigger asthma for people not equipped with proper protective gear.

Spray foam insulation for metal roofing Columbus Ohio homes have can either be applied tightly or loosely, open cell or closed cell insulation. The difference between the two is the amount of foam sprayed: open cell insulation has less foam and is therefore cheaper, while closed cell insulation has more foam offering more protection. The choice would depend on your budget and your needs.
