When you put company retreats, wedding functions, and ballrooms in one box, what do you get? Simple: you get the need for a huge floor area where lots of guests can enjoy the food and fun such affairs bring. This is because banquets in general have one thing in common: a substantial number of attendees as well as the celebrant and event staff. One is fine, two is a party, and three is a crowd, but four or more attendees may call for an event center.

As the organizer of a particular event, you would not want any associate of yours to be left out from all the fun. Suddenly, you ask yourself where to fit tons of guests in one place at any given time. You require a massive floor area for the visitors to move around, besides a place for the buffet table, stage, tables and chairs, and other party items. When it comes to party planning, floor space means everything.

The following examples to be touched on later call for a big venue not only because of the huge number of guests, but also because they want to move. Give anyone a few square feet of breathing space, say no more than 12 square feet, and that should be enough. Don't forget to check your guest list often so you can consider the space to be booked with the number of attendees in mind. The most vital thing is that they do not become unruly, thus increasing the chances of somebody getting hurt.

Ballroom. Should your guests decide to dance the night away, the space should be wide enough to allocate adequate room for a ballroom floor. Also, because the type of ballroom Denver CO partygoers use typically involves dancing as a pair, they require elbow room even more. Remember that couples need at least nine square feet, and not everybody will always be dancing simultaneously. In this case, you do not need to compute the total dance floor area for the final number of guests.
