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Having a disability should not be a hindrance for you to finish your education but that is not the case most of the time. A lot of people are hindered from finishing their education because they have disabilities. Some are discouraged from going to school because it is very challenging for them to navigate a regular school environment with their physical or learning disability. The most common reason why disabled persons do not get to go to school is the lack of money.

Unlike regular students, they could not easily get a part time job and save up for school because there are limited job opportunities for individuals with disabilities. You can spend it on buying books, a laptop or other things that you will need to help you in your studies. If you need special assistance during your classes such as a sign language interpreter or someone to take notes then you can also use the money to pay for those services.

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
