Ask around. Research

Inspect the facilities and the program

Make sure the facilities are up-to-date and the programs are appropriate for the kid's level. Some daycare centers such as Little Sunshine's Playhouse even have "eekiddie cams" installed in every classroom and playground, which helps parents monitor their children even while they're at work. These cameras are streamed live and you can access it online via secure username and password. They also evaluate your child's developmental progress on a bi-annual basis.

Visit the facilities at different times of the day

According to the Guidelines for Choosing Quality Child Care by Yale University, parents should visit the facilities at different parts of the day to get an accurate overview of the facilities. By visiting in the middle of the day, you can witness firsthand the way caregivers and educators interact with the children. At Little Sunshine's Playhouse, you could check out the classes and their respective activities which are streamed online.
