As Germany's second-largest city after Berlin, Hamburg is a vast and varied place with plenty of things to do and see. For those looking for something more adventurous, there are cruises along the Elbe where passengers will be able to see where some of the world's largest ships are built.

For something a little different, visit the Fish Market on a Sunday. Visitors will have to get up early to be part of the action, but it's worth it to see a bubbling, vibrant, colourful and unique part of Hamburg. Finally, after experiencing the sights and sounds of Hamburg, indulge in a Turkish bath at the Hamam Hafen Hamburg.
