The hard disk capacity is 500 GB with Dolby Digital as the default feature. The picture resolution is available up to 1080i and Video-on-demand content can be viewed in 1080p. It also has the features like picture-in-picture, on screen caller ID with history, etc.

The most amazing piece of machinery among the DISH Network receivers is the ViP 922 Slingloaded DVR. It has 1 TB of storage space which is the highest one available in the whole market. External hard disks can also be added through the USB port on this DVR. The built-in Sling technology makes TV mobile â€” watch the content of your television on your desktop or cell phones. There is an app for the various smartphones out there like BlackBerry, iPhone, Android and Windows Mobile Devices which lets anyone use a web browser to watch TV content over Wi-Fi or 3G connectivity. The content from the computer can also be streamed on the television by this DISH Network receiver.
